


I can read this now to get ready for our trip to Maitland Regional Art Gallery. It is also called MRAG for short.

All the artworks are made with different materials.


I can look and listen in the Gallery but I can't touch the art.

Or the back door



When I go into the Gallery I will be in the welcome area. There is a large front desk.








I can see a Gallery staff person at the desk.

I can walk around the hallway; sometimes it has art on the walls...








I can walk through the doorway in the hall and find another large Gallery space.







There is another doorway to explore. Through it I can find the front window Project Space which looks out onto the main street.









Now I can go up to the first floor.

I can go up the marble staircase and enjoy the view as I go.








Or I can use the lift. It is safer to go with someone else. The lift makes a small bang when I reach the first floor. This is a normal sound and I am safe.









Now I am upstairs and there are more spaces with art to explore.

I can enjoy the view from the first-floor balcony. It's a long way down but the railing will keep me safe.










Upstairs there is a hallway of artwork and an extra-large Gallery space which is sometimes divided up. I can slowly make my way between each room.








I can make my way over the bridge and through the archway to enjoy another Gallery space.










I can walk down the ramp to explore.

When I have finished exploring I can go back to the marble staircase.











I can walk back downstairs and wave at the friendly staff on my way to the last exhibition. Then I can go back to the large front desk.









From here I can see the café and the Gallery shop.

I will hear lots of people talking in this space. Sometimes it is loud.








I may be able to visit the shop. The shop sells books, cards and even cups! I will be careful while I look around.

If I want to touch something I will ask the gallery staff person.








Behind the shop are the toilets.


If I need help finding them I can ask the Gallery staff at the large front desk for help.






When I am finished using the toilet I will wash my hands. There are hand dryers in the toilet. They can be noisy.

Some people use them after they wash their hands. I do not have to use them. I can use paper towel instead.








If I need to take a break at any time during my visit I can sit down on one of the leaf shaped benches.









I can also sit outside in the garden for some quiet. I can sit in the sun or in the shade.







I might even like to try a Codebreaker activity to explore the Gallery. These are lots of fun! I can get one at the large front desk.










When I'm finished having fun I can return my activity supplies back there!
