## CREATE AN ANIMATED ARTWORK WITH STOP MOTION!

## YOU'LL NEED

- Paper
- Smart Phone or iPad
- Animation App
- Tripod, chair, or table
- Rubber bands
- Modelling clay, plasticine or playdough
- Pencils or textas
- An idea of what artwork you would like to animate.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

 Download the App 'Stop Motion Studio' onto your smart phone. 'Click New Movie'. It's a good idea to put the phone on 'aeroplane' mode or 'do not disturb' while completing the activity.



- 2. Think about what you might like to animate it's always good to have a few ideas to play around with, keep it very simple at first and then you can always add on ideas if you have time. A great place to start is to create a simple scene and have different elements move.
- 3. Put the paper onto the floor or a flat surface and secure with some tape.



Place the phone onto a tripod, table or chair. You could use rubber bands to steady the phone or iPad to a piece of wood or a book with screen facing up and the camera facing down.

- 4. Using the clay, create an art work or scene you would like to animate on the paper
- 5. Take a photo using the app, and then move the clay artwork slightly and take another photo. It works best if the movements are done in small increments, taking as many still photos as possible as the picture starts to move.

\*Extension Activity: Use pencils or textas to create a backdrop for your animation or an animated title/ending. Perhaps recreate a famous artwork!
