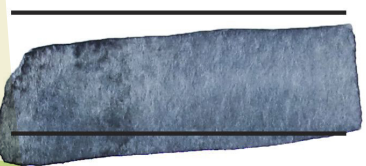
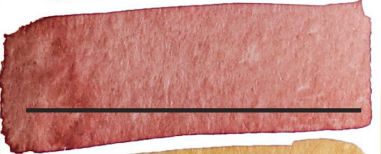
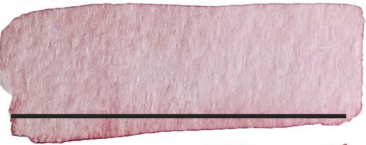
An Artful Nature Walk
