

Conditions of Entry

While at the Gallery you are welcome to:

- take photos (without flash) and film for private purposes, except in areas where photography and filming are signed as restricted.
- bring Guide Dogs and other registered assistance animals into the Gallery. Other animals are not permitted.
- take notes or make sketches with graphite pencils and handheld sketchbooks and clipboards

For your safety, the safety of others and the safety of our artwork you must:

- not touch, or in any other way, interfere with artworks. You are welcome to interact with artworks designated and labelled as interactive
- not consume food or drinks (including water) in Gallery spaces, except in Seraphine café.
- deposit with Gallery staff, as soon as possible after entry, bags deemed to be large by the Gallery, umbrellas, or any other item, as directed by the Gallery team
- not run in Gallery spaces
- not smoke.

The Gallery reserves the right to:

- photograph, film or record events and activities taking place on Gallery premises for reporting, archival and promotional purposes
- use Security Closed Circuit Television cameras throughout the Gallery (for more information, see the Gallery's Information Privacy Statement).
- MRAG reserves the right to remove individuals from the Gallery that are exhibiting any conduct or behaviours that cause, or is likely to cause alarm, harassment, fear, distress or intimidation to someone, or cause damage to property.

This includes:

- Any conduct or behaviour which threatens the health or safety of yourself, MRAG employees, MRAG Volunteers, contractors, or visitors;
- Any conduct or behaviour that is violent, threatening, intimidating, offensive, objectionable, humiliating, or inconsiderate;
- Any conduct that creates a disturbance, is disruptive or disorderly or public nuisance;
- Any conduct or behaviour which causes, or may cause, disruption to MRAG business or operations;
- Any conduct or behaviour which interferes with the artwork, frames, platforms, labels, display cases or any other objects on display in exhibitions, displays or otherwise throughout the Gallery;
- Conducting solicitation, leafleting, signature gathering, canvassing, or hawking within MRAG;
- Refusing to comply with MRAG Conditions of Entry.
