EXHIBITION AND CREATIVE PROGRAM PROPOSALS FOR 2026- 2028

Maitland Regional Art Gallery is calling for exhibition and program proposals for two spaces in the 2026-2028 program. Both spaces are considered project spaces and can be used for a range of purposes including installation of exhibitions, creative making and/or project experiences.

Artists will receive an artist fee and may be required to help with installation / de-installation.

We will accept EOI's from Monday 31 March and close submission Friday 25 April 2025.

SUBMITTING YOUR PROPOSAL

If you would like your creative project, exhibition or experience to be considered for inclusion to the Maitland Regional Art Gallery future program, you can submit a proposal including:

- Images (10 maximum)
- CV/ BIO (including contact details)
- links to website/instagram (if available)
- an exhibition statement (approx. one page)

Your exhibition statement must include an artist's statement/conceptual premise and a description of the project.

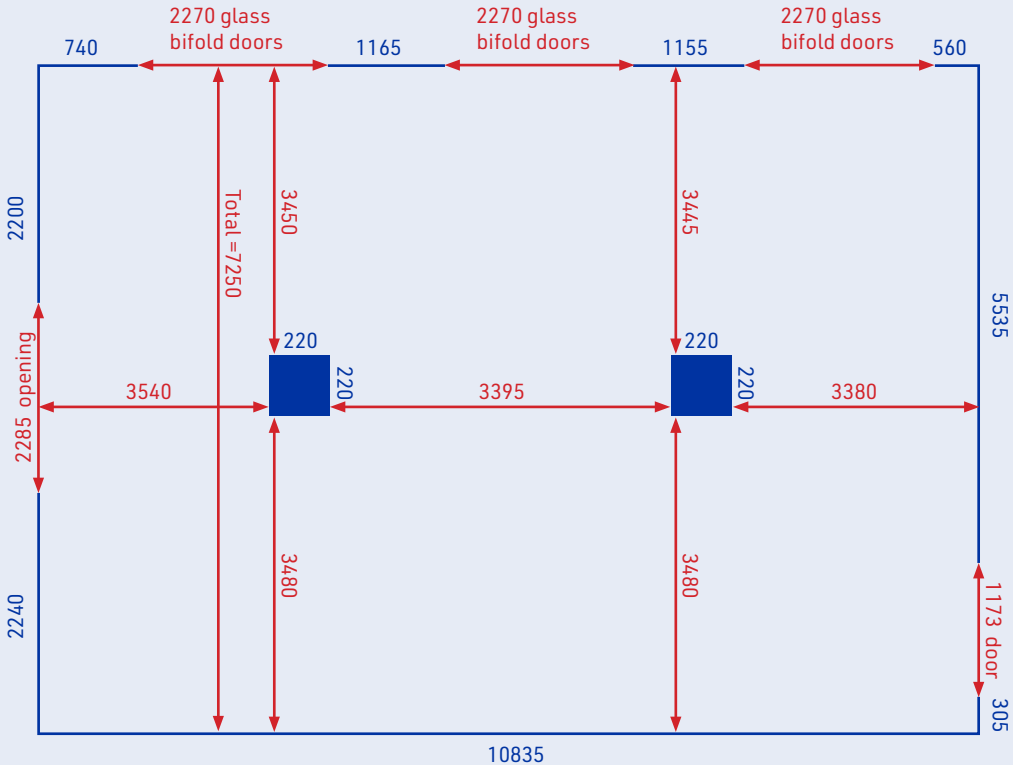


PROJECT SPACE 1

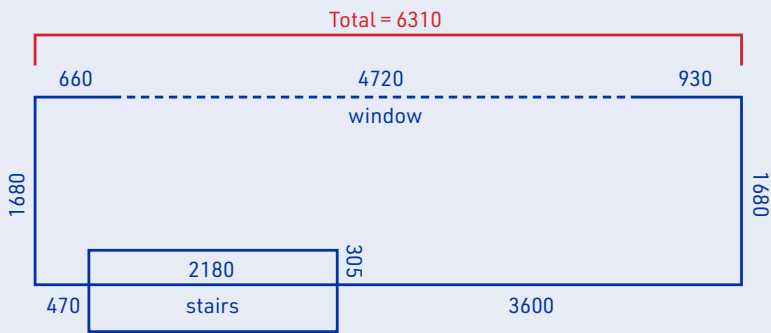

PROJECT SPACE 2

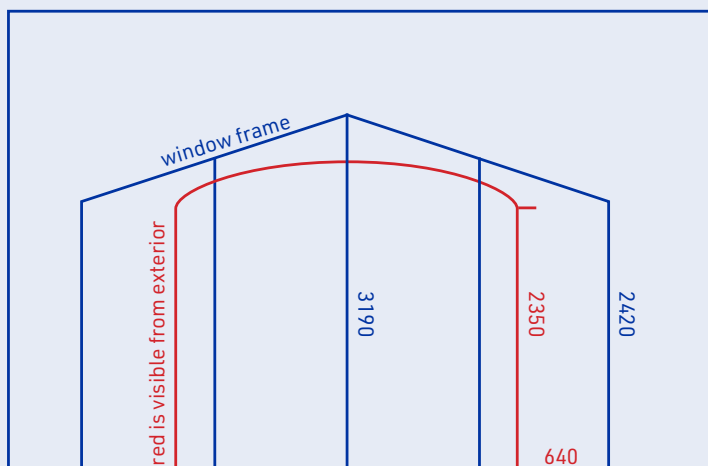
